2016 ORGANIC SHIRAZ

Baileys of Glenrowan is one of the pioneers of winemaking in North-East Victoria, producing its first vintage in 1870. Since this time, Glenrowan has become a world-renowned winemaking region. Baileys of Glenrowan continues to be recognised today as an acclaimed producer of full-flavoured red and luscious fortified wines.

Our founder, Richard Bailey, crafted our first Shiraz back in 1870. After the Baileys of Glenrowan vineyards became certified organic in 2011, we produced our first Organic Shiraz in 2012. This wine is made in tribute to those traditional winemaking techniques, upgraded with modern influences. The result is a sustainable Shiraz of great character.

Winemaker's Note	A deep garnet colour that is clear at the rim, this Shiraz offers lifted and floral aromas, abundant with fresh cherry and raspberry fruits, laced by attractive spicy whole bunch notes. This is a medium bodied wine balanced by savoury red fruits, fine tannin and well-integrated toasted French oak. Enjoy now or cellar until 2022.			
Vintage	Vintage 2016 showed excellent growing conditions, with good Spring rains and mild, settled conditions throughout the ripening period. This resulted in table wines of immense fruit concentration.			
Vineyards	Crafted from Shiraz grapes sourced from Baileys of Glenrowan Block 16.			
Winemaking	Made in open fermenters with the inclusion of 23% whole bunches, matured for 12 months in a mixture of seasoned French oak.			
Enjoy	Pairs beautifully with classic veal dishes and light game meats, such as duck or quail.
