Our Small Batch Series is crafted as the best expression of the unique landscape and climate of our Bundarra vineyard, planted over ancient red granite soils. These wines are produced organically to showcase the diversity of varietals in the region.

#### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

An even growing season without any heat spikes allowed fruit to ripen slowly and be harvest at peak timing. Vines were well balanced also delivering ideal conditions for fruit to naturally vine ripen.

#### WINEMAKING & MATURATION

Treated softly in the winery with no crushing, to retain flavour and brightness. Gently pressed into older French oak to build complexity for maturation, and some time in tank to maximise juicy freshness.

#### COLOUR

Bight crimson colour.

#### NOSE/ AROMA

Cherry and mulberry aromas.

#### PALATE

A spicy, fruit driven mid-palate with supple tannins and a long savoury finish.

#### ANALYSIS

Alc/Vol 13.50% T.A 5.7g/L pH 3.26

#### PEAK DRINKING

Best consumed whilst young and fresh.

#### ENJOY

Serve at room temperature or try chilling lightly just before serving. Beautifully accompanies game meats like duck or even succulent pork dishes.
